



100-club

Rumbletums offers non-accredited training and work experience opportunities to young people aged 16 to 30 with a learning disability, some of whom may also have an additional physical disability. The training is based around our community café.

The **100-club** is a great way of supporting Rumbletums whilst having a bit of a flutter!

In summary, here's how it works...

- the club is limited to 100 members, who each pay £5 a month
- each member is allocated a number between 1 and 100
- a draw takes place every month on the last day the café is open each month, and three prizes are given every month (with four bigger prizes in November)
- winners are paid within 3 days, either by BACS or cheque
- winning numbers are published each month, along the names of winners, unless they wish to remain anonymous. This will be in the Café, on Facebook and on the Rumbletums website
- all of the income generated is used for prizes and to support the Rumbletums project.

100-club rules

- 1 The 100-club is run by a Promoter, who is a Rumbletums Trustee who has been authorised by the Rumbletums Board to run the 100-club.
- 2 The 100-club is limited to 100 members. Anyone aged 18 or over can join, including Rumbletums staff and Directors.
- 3 Members each pay £5 a month, preferably by Standing Order, or in advance by cheque or cash.
- 4 Each member is allocated a number between 1 and 100. A member may request a particular number which will be allocated if not already taken. If a requested number is not available, the Promoter will allocate the number.
- 5 The draw takes place every month regardless of the number of members, and prizes are a percentage of that month's payments, as follows:

- Each month, except November		With 100 members, this is
First prize	20%	£100
Second prize	10%	£50
Third prize	5%	£25

First prize	50%	£250
Second prize	30%	£150
2 x Third prizes of	10%	2 X £50
- 6 Members' numbers are only entered into the monthly draw if their subscriptions are up to date.
- 7 If a member has no valid reason for missing a payment, their number may be sold to someone on the reserve list.
- 8 The draw takes place on the last day the café is open each month. It is conducted by the Promoter, or if unavailable another Trustee acting on their behalf.
- 9 Winners are paid within 3 days, either by BACS or cheque.
- 10 The winning numbers are published each month, along the names of winners, unless they wish to remain anonymous. This will be in the Café, on Facebook and on the Rumbletums website.
- 11 Unless otherwise advised, a member will be deemed to have left the 100-club if his/her subscription remains unpaid for more than two months.
- 12 If a winner cannot be contacted, the winnings will be placed into Rumbletums funds after six months.
